



Assessment Grid

The Assessment Grid works well for evaluating a large group or perhaps the whole class. Examples for using the grid are displayed below. The 1, 2, 3, 4 is a code indicating level of proficiency.

Each child's name can be placed in a box. As the teacher observes, he or she can tick off the appropriate level. The remaining space can be used for comments.
